2 RS Feva Sailing Boats £4,350 each



These dynamic youth class boats have a huge following at National and International events.

Our sailing team are very talented and need the opportunity to train using high-quality boats of a racing pedigree. The RS Feva is a very competitive and exciting class and our pupils are thriving in the two new boats.

Tennis Wall £11,600

This practice/warm up aid is a valuable addition to coaches who can demonstrate and assess racket technique and performance close at hand to groups or individuals whilst on court. It also offers the advantage of a virtual playing partner for practice as well as warm up.

It can easily be installed to existing tennis courts, providing a high quality practice facility within any tennis court or play area.

Hockey and Rugby Digital Scoreboard £13,000



A digital scoreboard specially commissioned by Millfield providing fully programmable team names, timing systems and spectator messages for hockey, football and rugby matches. The scoreboard is located between the hockey and rugby pitches and can be seen by spectators and players at the pitch side or within the new Sports Pavilion.

This is a treat for dedicated parents wanting to keep track of the timings and score.





2 GoPro Helmet Cameras £400 each

The resolution on these cameras is crisp enough to be used for videos and photographs, which the pupils can use for project work, to share with parents or for their own memories. The cameras cost much less than a professional photographer and capture footage from a spectacular aspect.

We would use these constantly through the sailing, climbing, caving, cross country, fencing, equestrian, kit car, sub-aqua, and trampolining clubs.



Interactive SMART Board £8,700

This technology is being introduced to replace projectors and interactive whiteboards in teaching rooms. It ties in well with our mobile learning project and although it is not essential, it will work particularly well with our younger pupils who have learnt to interact with touch screen technology from a very young age.

The school would like to introduce a 70" model which includes a PC module.

Portable TV Studio £13,000

A portable television studio will bring a whole new learning experience to our pupils. They will be able to understand and utilise the power of the moving image to record, manipulate, influence and create. Imagine an edited highlight reel of a match, post-match interviews, a behind the scenes report on a production or a study guide made for and by the pupils.

This studio will enable pupils to produce recordings and learn how to edit, script write, record and speak to the camera – skills which are useful in so many fields.

4 Radio Microphones £150 each

In our exciting drama programme specialist facilities are important to help our pupils focus on the task in hand. Radio microphones are in high demand and we currently use them as part of the Year 6, 7 and 8 drama productions. The Junior department also use them, and so we continually hire them in. The next progression for us is to purchase our own.

Wicker Maze £1,600

A set of 18 panels in two sizes offering an exciting and challenging task to our Pre-Prep pupils of creating their own wicker maze.

As a group and logic activity we would like to offer our pupils the task of creating pathways which will stimulate conversation, exciting play and learning opportunities. This wicker range has been made from willow which is woven on to sturdy metal frames to ensure a safe and long lasting den.

Each piece of willow equipment can be easily assembled and has rubber plastic caps on the end of the metal frame allowing for indoor use.

Outdoor Classroom £14,500

This amazing outdoor classroom is a fantastic way to get children out into the fresh air whilst being in a learning environment.

Not only does this teach children that learning outdoors can be as much fun or even better than a school classroom, but the option of learning outside is a wonderful facility to have and will enhance the education of so many children. Used to its full potential, the outdoor classroom will also be a glorious play shelter in summer time.

Musical Sculptures £5,200



These interactive musical sculptures have been installed in the playground and pupils are taught each year to use them by our percussion teacher. They are extremely popular and encourage teamwork, cooperation and the development of musical skills.

3 Go-Karts £350 each

Our current stock of go-karts are very popular and well used by Millfield Prep boarders on Sundays and weekday evenings. They are also kept busy with multi activities on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

These go-karts allow pupils to feel, hear and see the Somerset countryside. With brakes and a high quality steering mechanism which is extremely manoeuvrable and safe.
