



Clothing Guide

Junior and Sixth Form Boys

Dress for school working day:

- Plain dark suit (pin stripe allowed). Trousers must have a vertical crease.
- Shirt – must be light coloured (plain, striped or check) and designed to be worn with a tie.
- Tie – only ties available in the Senior School Shop (school, house, prefect or colours).
- Black shoes (clean, polishable and smart). No trainers, suede, canvas shoes or boots.
- Jumper (optional) – must be the school V necked jumper purchased from the School Shop. No other sweater or cardigan may be worn by Junior Boys.
- Coat – must be smart and plain (no motifs) and must cover the whole jacket. No bomber jackets, fleeces or sports tops are allowed.
- Hair should be neat and off the collar: it should be neither shaved, sculpted nor tinted, and should not impair vision. Alice bands and top knots are not allowed.
- Boys are expected to have shaved for School.

Formal dress for away matches and HM assemblies:

- Dark suit and white shirt.
- Black shoes (clean, polishable and smart).
- School tie.

The above dress code applies to all boys. In addition, **Sixth Formers** are allowed to wear the following:

- Jumper – **plain V neck**. No collars or roll necks.
- Waistcoat – plain or to match suit.
- A light coloured (not white) suit of conventional material (not linen) may be worn in the summer term only.
- A cardigan – must be plain, dark coloured and suitable for wearing under a jacket.

Other items for boarders for evening/weekend wear

- Earphones which will be needed for English testing first week
- Casual clothes and shoes
- Nightwear
- Hold-all / case for schoolbooks
- Underwear, accessories and toiletries.
- Hand towels
- Bath towels
- Linen bags (required for laundry).

Laundry is taken in once a week and usually returned within 48 hours. Therefore, please ensure that your child has sufficient clothes, towels etc. to survive for about ten days.

Routine laundry carries no extra charge to parents, but a charge will be made for hand washing and dry cleaning.

Junior Girls (Years 9, 10 & 11)

Dress for school working day

- School jacket.
- School skirt – hemline must be on or just below the knee (trousers are available via the school shop by special arrangement prior to arrival).
- 'V' neck school jumper. No other jumper or cardigan may be worn during the school day.
- School shirt. This should be tucked into skirt at all times.

All clothes should fit properly, being neither baggy nor unduly tight in order to allow safe freedom of movement within the school environment. **Junior girls must purchase the above items from the School Shop.**

- Shoes should be clean, smart, have a back and maximum 4cm heel. They should be plain and dark. Canvas shoes are not allowed.
- Coats should be smart, dark and plain. They must cover the jacket. Bomber jackets are not allowed.
- Jewellery - only small stud type earrings are allowed and only one in each ear. Other piercings are not allowed. A simple necklace and bracelet is allowed.
- Make-up, if worn, must be very discreet. No nail varnish allowed.
- Hair should be well groomed.
- Formal dress - school jacket, skirt, blue blouse and dark shoes.
- Tights should be plain - dark or neutral in colour.

Other items for boarders for evening/weekend wear

- Earphones which will be needed for English testing first week
- Casual clothes and shoes
- Nightwear
- Hold-all / case for schoolbooks
- Underwear, accessories and toiletries.
- Hand towels

Sixth Form Girls

No item needs to be purchased from the School Shop. However, Sixth Form girls are required to wear:

- A smart, tailored business suit with trousers, skirt or dress made from the same matching fabric. Trousers should be tailored and not of legging style. No jeans. Hemlines of dress/skirt must be on or just below the knee. Material must be of a conventional type, not leather or shiny fabrics.
- Shirts should have a collar. They should be made of conventional shirt material (not see through). They must completely cover the waistband of trousers or skirts at all times and not show below the jacket. No vest tops are allowed.
- Jumpers or cardigans, if worn, must be lightweight, plain and suitable for wearing under a jacket (no polo necks).
- Shoes should be clean, smart, have a back and a maximum 5cm heel. Canvas shoes not acceptable. Boots, if worn, must be covered by the trousers. No UGG boots. Dark shoes are required for formal wear. Tights should be dark or neutral in colour. Ankle boots are only allowed with full length trousers which should sit outside the boots.
- Jewellery should be simple and discreet. Earrings, if worn, should be simple and appropriate for school wear and only one in each ear. Other piercings are not allowed.
- Hair should be well groomed.
- Make-up (including nail varnish), if worn, should be discreet.
- Coats should be smart, dark in colour and plain. They must cover the jacket. Bomber jackets are not allowed.
- Formal dress: A smart, tailored suit of matching fabric, white collared shirt, dark shoes.

Other items for boarders for evening/weekend wear

- Earphones which will be needed for English testing first week
- Casual clothes and shoes

- Hold-all / case for schoolbooks
- Underwear, accessories and toiletries.
- Hand towels
- Bath towels

Sports Equipment

Millfield is supported by Kukri sportswear, and all official sports, games and PE clothing must be from the Kukri range, purchased through the School Shop. The shop is open most of the holidays for appointments as well as during term time.

Core Games Wear

The following items from Kukri's Millfield sportswear core range are required for all Junior pupils:

- Crew socks
- Shorts (boys) or skort (girls)
- Polo shirt
- Tracksuit bottoms
- Performance fleece
- Track top or rain top
- House top
- Swim trunks or swimsuit (from Millfield's Arena range)

The following items from Kukri's Millfield sportswear range are required for all Senior pupils, and may be drawn from either the core range or the 1st team range of one of our sports (if eligible)

- Tracksuit bottoms
- Performance fleece
- House top
- Training shoes

Sport Specific Wear

Depending on the term the following items from Kukri's Millfield sportswear sport specific ranges are required for those pupils choosing these games:

- Rugby / football /hockey socks
- Rugby shorts and generic rugby jersey
- Reversible basketball vest
- Cricket shirt and flannels
- Cricket performance sweater
- Athletics vest

In addition, relevant to their games choices, pupils are required to provide:

- Rugby / football boots (NB: blade football boots are not permitted for any games due to injury risks)
- Astro-turf trainers
- Cricket boots
- Hockey stick
- Cricket bat
- Tennis racket
