 4. It would be advantageous to have experience of coaching in multiple event areas.
 5. Any other duties that the Director of Athletics sees fit to fulfil the role as required.
- The role will require the applicant to work for 4 hours per week between 2 and 6pm on a Thursday in Millfield term time only
