



Instrumental Music Lessons

I understand that as from 1st September 2019 the charge for instrumental tuition at the school will be £279 per instrument per term (for up to 30 lessons per academic year). There is a reduction in fees if two or more instruments are learnt. The termly rate for second and subsequent instruments is £255.

Any additional lessons over the thirty will need to be cleared with the Director of Music and will be charged at £27.90 for the first instrument per lesson and £25.50 per lesson for subsequent instruments. This will be invoiced in **arrears** at the end of each term.

Any music books provided will also be charged to my account alongside the hire charge for the use of a school instrument is £35 per term (if applicable).

I understand that **one term's written** notice is required should my child wish to discontinue his/her lessons at any stage. This notice also applies should my child wish to change instrumental teachers at any stage. If you have private Music Theory lessons you will be charged half a term's notice if you cease tuition prior to taking Grade 5.

If your child has already had lessons, please answer the following questions. If not, please indicate if you wish to hire a school instrument and then sign the declaration at the bottom of the form and return it to the Music Department Secretary, Mrs Jules Kew at the school address.
